

# AP PHYSICS B Class Supplies List

(get them while they are on sale this summer!!)

This will be your first homework assignment, to be checked on the first day of school!

If you have difficulty doing this very elementary assignment, you may find the rest of AP Physics way too challenging, and thus a serious visit to your guidance counselor may be necessary.

- 1) 3-Ring Binder (*no, NOT a trapper folder, NOT a spiral book, NOT a composition book*)  
1"-2" (You'll be able to clean it out after each unit, or you can use a bigger binder and share with other subjects.) (20 pts.)
- 2) Loose-leaf paper  
You don't need gallons of it, but get a package and refill your binder as necessary. (20 pts.)
- 3) A pencil case that attaches in the binder (I know they're geeky, but get one anyway!)  
(20 pts.)  
filled with:
  - A few pencils
  - A few pens
  - A white-out wheel (the type that rolls, not the liquid)
- 4) A scientific calculator (20 pts.)  
Any type of calculator is fine, EXCEPT for HP calculators. You will not need to do any programming, but you will need to know how to enter and calculate using numbers in scientific notation.
- 5) HOMEWORK BOOK (20 pts.) (any book with graph paper is acceptable).  
An example shown is a Mead 4 Square / 5 Square Quad wireless notebook with 4 squares per inch on the front of each sheet and 5 squares per inch on the back (different square sizes are acceptable).
  - Size: 8-1/2" x 11".
  - Bound on side (top bound is acceptable)
  - 3-hole punched (not required)
  - 80 sheets per notebook preferred (any page quantity is acceptable)
